

HAMMOCKS CAPE HAZE – FLAG POLICY

The Hammocks Master Association is responsible for the following concerning the display and maintenance of the American Flag and Flagpole that is displayed at the entrance to the property.

Flag Display

- No flag will be flown from the Hammocks flagpole other than the flag of the United States of America.
- The Master Association Board of Directors is responsible for the half mast authorization and will follow U.S. Federal Code guidelines.

Flag Replacement

- From time to time, the flag will need to be replaced due to wear and fading.
- The replacement flag should be 8' x 12', highest quality, and made in the USA.
- The old flag must be retired properly; it may be taken to any veterans' organization for disposal.

Maintenance

- In the event of high sustained winds in excess of 40 mph, the flag must be taken down to prevent damage to the flag and pole.
- The light at the base of the pole must be maintained to ensure the flag and pole are illuminated at night.
- At least one Hammocks employee will be familiar with the operation of the flag pole and the halyard system. A key and crank should be in the possession of a Hammocks employee.

Notes

- Currently replacement flags are provided by private funds. Homeowner Larry Stauffer provided a replacement flag (April 2019).
- At this time volunteer homeowners, Larry Stauffer and Sam Desiderio conduct the half-mast duties guided by the American Legion Website and other national sources.
- Facilities Manager John Schwab is trained in flagpole operations and has a key and crank.
